

MAKING A SIGN

Picture Frame must be completed to do sign. Must have design by the end of the period on Friday

1. Design a sign. Can be no bigger than a standard piece of paper. (8 1/2" by 11") Designs must be draw exactly how you want them to appear on the sign. When designing your sign don't have the lines too close together. If your sign has words, I suggest you use a computer and print it out this will look a lot better than just free handing the words.
2. Transfer design onto a piece of wood.
3. Use the portable router to cut design into the wood.
4. Sand off all pencil marks with Power Sander.
5. Clean up mess made by router and portable sander
6. Paint inside design and let paint dry 1 day in cabinet. Next step is for the following day.
7. Sand off all paint and sand with 220 Grit and use Router Table if you want design around outside of sign.
8. OPTIONAL: Paint on surface of wood and let dry one day before going onto next step.
9. Spray with varnish let dry in cabinet.
10. Sign will be dry after school the day you varnish.
